

Elderly crime study panel adds McAlevey, Cantara

Rep. Michael McAlevey, R-Waterboro, and York County District Attorney Michael P. Cantara have been appointed to the Department of Human Services Study Group on Prosecution of Crimes Against the Elderly. The committee seeks to identify crimes against elderly people and propose legislation to prevent them.

The group will meet three more times before November, and will report its findings to the Legislature.

"I am looking forward to working on this study group with Cantara," said McAlevey.

"The crimes committed against the elderly hit a segment of the population that is most vulnerable to exploitation, both physical and financial, and any steps taken to strengthen the state's ability to protect our elderly citizens are welcome," said Cantara. "I am pleased

to have been asked to serve on this study group."
